## WEED CONTROL IN LANDSCAPE BEDS

A simple guide for homeowners to manage weeds safely and effectively.

### NON-CHEMICAL OPTIONS

- **Hand Removal** — Pull weeds when soil is moist for easier removal. Grasp at the base and remove the entire root to prevent regrowth.
- **30% Vinegar Spot Treatment** — Apply directly to weed foliage on a dry, sunny day. Avoid contact with desirable plants. Works best on young, tender weeds.

### CHEMICAL SPOT-SPRAY OPTIONS

- **Glyphosate** — Active ingredient in RoundUp® and many generic products. Effective for spot-treating weeds in mulch beds.

**Directions** — Spray to *wet the leaves only*. Do **not** drench the soil. Avoid drift or contact with surrounding plants.

**Generic Product Use** — Purchasing a generic glyphosate product and mixing it at the recommended rates often provides the best results for effective spot treatment. This approach allows for cost savings and flexibility while maintaining effectiveness when applied correctly.

### PRE-EMERGENT HERBICIDE (PREVENTION)

- **Snapshot® (Trifluralin + Isoxaben)** — Applied to mulch beds, this product significantly reduces new weed growth.
- We apply Snapshot with all mulch jobs to help keep beds cleaner throughout the season.

### IMPORTANT APPLICATION NOTES

- Always avoid spraying desirable plants.
- Apply on calm days to prevent drift.

- Spot-spray only — do not saturate the soil.
- Reapply pre-emergent after heavy disturbance or new mulch installation.
